### **NOTICE OF RACE (revised)**

#### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The following prescriptions of the US Sailing will not apply: 60, 63.2, 63.4 and 82
- 1.3 The rules of Southern California PHRF will be in effect for all PHRF classes. Any rules governing marine industry representatives are waived for all PHRF classes.
- 1.4 Class rules for any one design classes will apply. Class rules governing marine industry representatives will be per the class rules of individual classes.
- 1.5 RRS Appendix T, Section A T1 will change RRS 44.1.
- 1.6 RRS Appendix T, Section B T2 and Section D T5 will apply for dispute 18 February 2015 resolution
- 1.7 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

#### **2 ADVERTISING**

Advertising is permitted per ISAF regulations

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats with a LOA of 14 feet or greater within the following sections
  - 3.1.1 PHRF up to 282 handicap (SoCal PHRF membership is encouraged but not required)
  - 3.1.2 Recognized one design class associations
  - 3.1.3 Portsmouth handicap
- 3.2 The OA reserves the right to assign handicaps to boats that do not have a valid PHRF certificate
- 3.3 Division breaks will be determined by the OA.
- 3.4 Eligible boats may enter on-line at regatta network or [www.khyc.com](http://www.khyc.com). Any questions regarding the entry process contact KHYC. Entry closes March 27 at 1700

### **4 CLASSES**

- 4.1 Classes will be divided into the following categories
  - 4.1.1 PHRF
  - 4.1.2 One design with separate starts for fleets of 3 or more entries
  - 4.1.3 Cruiser Fleet with random leg course
  - 4.1.4 Multi-Hull with Portsmouth ratings

### **5 FEES**

- 5.1 Required fees are as follows:

<u>Class</u>	<u>Fees</u>
14 to 20 feet	\$60
21 to 29 feet	\$95
30 to 39 feet	\$125
40 feet and over	\$175

- 5.2 A \$15 discount will be applied for entries submitted before 2300 March 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015
- 5.3 A late fee of \$25 will be applied for entries received after 1700 on March 27<sup>th</sup>. Any entries submitted after this time will be at the discretion of the OA

- 6.4 Competitors briefing 1000 on March 28<sup>th</sup> at KHYC
- 6.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1130.

## **7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after 1200 on March 27.

## **8 VENUE**

- 8.1 The regatta headquarters will be at the King Harbor Yacht Club
- 8.2 The racing area will be Santa Monica Bay area between the Hermosa Beach and Manhattan Beach Piers

## **9 THE COURSES**

Courses will be W/L type courses for the racing fleets. A random leg distance course for the cruising fleet is planned

## **10 SCORING**

- 10.1 PHRF will be time on time
- 10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 10.3 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. This changes RRS A2

## **11 BERTHING, STORAGE and PARKING**

- 11.1 KHYC will provide free mooring to all registered competitors from March 21 to March 30. Yachts must register with the KHYC office
- 11.2 Each registered yacht will receive one parking pass in the KHYC lot
- 11.3 KHYC will attempt to make space available to trailerable yachts to store their boat trailers and for race equipment trailers that are less than 26 feet. Please contact KHYC for more information.

## **12 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 12.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.
- 12.2 The RC will use VHF channel 78 to communicate with the fleet

### **13 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given for each section as follows:

- 1-3 boats - 1st only
- 1-5 boats - 1st, 2nd
- 1-7 boats - 1st-3rd
- 1-10+ boats - 1st-4th

### **14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

### **15 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance
