NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendices T1, T2 and T5 will apply.
- 1.3 The LMPHRF Rating System will apply to all boats.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The races are open to monohull keelboats with auxiliary motors and Etchells, Shields, Luders and Sonars moored in Belmont Harbor.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter one of four sections: Inshore One-Design, Jib and Main, Tartan Ten, J/105 or Offshore with Spinnaker.
- 2.3 Eligible boats may enter by submitting a completed Belmont Skyline Series Registration, together with any required fee, to the series contact prior to the first race in which the boat will sail. Entries will be accepted at the event website at www.chicagoyachtclub.org/offshoreracing.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee for the entire season will be \$95.
- 3.2 The entry fee for boats signing up after July 11 will be \$55.
- 3.3 The entry fee for a single race will be \$35.

4 SCHEDULE AND VENUE

- 4.1 Races are scheduled every Wednesday from May 20 through September 30, except for July 8 and July 15.
- 4.2 The races will be held in the open waters of Lake Michigan east of Belmont Harbor.
- 4.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1855 through August 26, 2015. The scheduled the of the warning signal for September 2 and 9 is 1840. The scheduled time of the warning signal for September 16, 23, and 30 is 1825...

Sailing instructions will be available two weeks prior to racing on the Chicago Yacht Club website and as a courtesy on the official notice board at the Chicago Yacht Club, Belmont Station.
