- 1. Rules:** The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing and the class rules of the invited classes.
- 2. Advertising:** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 3. Venue:** Cold Spring Beach, end of Beach Street, Wickford, RI 02852. The sailing area will be on the West Passage of Narragansett Bay. The Saturday dinner will be held at Wickford Yacht Club, 165 Pleasant Street, Wickford, RI.
- 4. Eligibility and Entry:** The regatta is open to the **Int. 505, F-18, Int. Canoe; Int. 420, Laser, and Laser Radial** classes. All entries shall conform to the eligibility rules of the respective classes.

5. Event Schedule

Friday June 5, 2015
1500-1800 Check in and late registration

Saturday June 6, 2015
0830-1000 Check-in and late registration
1000 Competitors meeting
1200 Warning signal first race. Subsequent races to follow immediately. Alpha Course classes may have a delayed start time to allow competitors taking SAT exams at North Kingstown High School to make the first race.

Sunday June 7, 2015
1000 Earliest possible start time. Subsequent races to follow immediately.
1500 No races to start after this time.

6.3 The entry fee includes light breakfast both days, dinner on Saturday night, and regatta hats (not guaranteed for late registrants). Lunches may only be pre-purchased at the time of **online** registration. Details are available on the event registration web page.

7. Sailing Instructions: The sailing instructions will be available at the event website after June 3, at check in or at the competitor's meeting.

8. Courses: Trapezoid or Windward-Leeward courses will be used for I-420, Club 420, Laser and Laser Radial Classes. All other classes will sail Windward-Leeward courses.

9. Scoring: The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A of the racing rules will apply. There will be one throw-out if 4 or more races have been completed. Eight races are scheduled, of which one shall be completed to constitute a series.

10. Disclaimer of Liability: Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta. Competitors will be required to complete a liability waiver at registration.

11. Prizes: Prizes will be awarded based upon the number of entries received through May 24th. 10 or more entries, top three. Fewer than 10, top two. Equal prizes will be awarded to both skipper and crew in double handed classes.
